

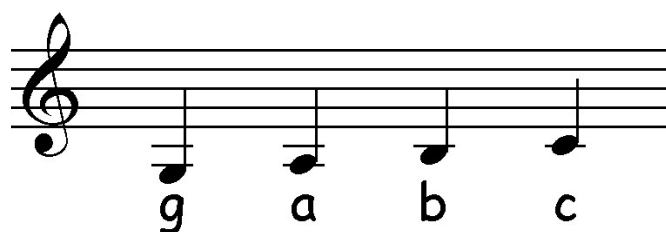
3rd Finger Notes On The Violin

When you press your 3rd finger down on the violin, put it right next to your 2nd finger. Don't leave any gap at all!

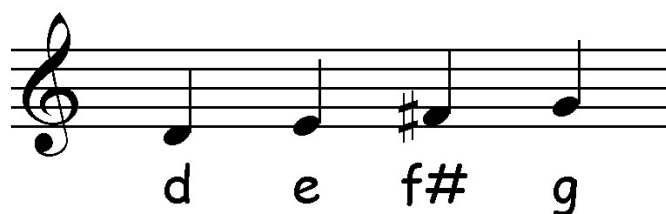
Make sure your 1st and 2nd fingers are also pressed down, in the correct places. This will give your 3rd finger more support and help you keep a good hand shape.

Practise playing all four notes on each string lots and lots of times! Your fingers need to develop strength and muscle memory.

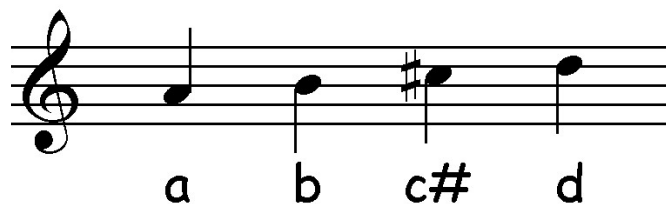
On the **G** string, the 3rd finger note is called **C** (you could think of it low C).



On the **D** string, the 3rd finger note is called **G** (you could think of it middle G).



On the **A** string, the 3rd finger note is called **D** (you could think of it high D).



On the **E** string, the 3rd finger note is called **A** (you could think of it high A).
